To diversify sources of return and risks, their portfolio is at all time invested in three main geographical areas: Europe, Asia and the Americas, and in different economic sectors.

Career history

Hubert worked in the field of portfolio management for over 30 years. He began his career at European Centre for Research on Investment in 1974 and thereafter as Managing Director of SECAFI, an independent portfolio management boutique. In 1992 SECAFI was merged with the brokerage firm Bonnewijn, Renwart Van Goethem & Co., where Hubert will serve as Head of Research and Portfolio Manager. In 2000, Hubert joined Banque Degroof following its acquisition of BRG. In 2005, he founded TreeTop Asset Management with Jacques Berghmans.
